Dear Parents,

Greetings from Global Mission International School!

The Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE), in alignment with the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, has issued guidelines for the implementation of the **Three-Language Policy** with effect from the Academic Session **2026–27**.

As per the policy, every student will study **three languages**, with **at least two being Bhartiya (Indian) Languages**. The objective is to promote multilingualism while ensuring a joyful, meaningful and enriching language-learning experience. In accordance with CBSE guidelines, **Global Mission International School** will implement the following language structure:

Important Points for Parents

- Class VI (2026–27) is the first batch that will appear for the CBSE Board Examination in the Third Language (R3) upon reaching Class X.
- The current batches of Classes VII, VIII and IX (2026–27) are transition batches. For these students, R3 will be assessed only through school-based internal assessment **It will not be a CBSE Board Examination subject.**
- Students studying in Classes VI to VIII are required to choose either Sanskrit or Gujarati as their Third Language (R3). Parents are requested to submit the Language Preference Consent Form by the prescribed **Date 11.08.26(Tuesday).**
- At every stage, the school will ensure compliance with CBSE norms while providing appropriate guidance and academic support to students and parents regarding language selection and progression.

We request your cooperation in implementing this important initiative under NEP 2020, which aims to provide students with a strong multilingual foundation.
